

## Hooton Park

### IndiKart Series Round 3

The 3<sup>rd</sup> round IndiKart Series took place at Hooton Park on the 18<sup>th</sup> March and a record entry of 76 enjoyed a great days racing in the championship for Non MSA licence holders.

In the Bambino class Max Barrow dominated all day after only qualifying 3<sup>rd</sup> fastest and won the final by nearly 10 secs to secure his 2<sup>nd</sup> successive maximum points. Noah Chamberlain drove a fine race after spinning in the second heat and worked his way up from 6<sup>th</sup> on the grid to take the second podium spot, with William Swann also moving through the field to take 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

Next up was Class C Cadets, including all cadet engines, such as Comer W60 and S60, WTP and Honda's. Scott Griffiths dominated the racing all day taking a comfortable win from Joe Willoughby in 2<sup>nd</sup>. The race for the last podium spot was a lot closer but it was Jay Shackleton who took 3<sup>rd</sup> fighting off the challenges from Ethan Jones and Max Barnbrook.

In Class A2 for the Senior 2 Strokes, David Buky took his first win in the Indikart Series and in doing so now leads the championship, with Tony Davies coming home a close 2<sup>nd</sup>. Matt Greenall took the last podium spot in 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

Class B was next up which includes all 4 stroke karts and Mike Kenworthy took the overall win in his GX390 from Glyn Williams in 2<sup>nd</sup> and Sean Evans finishing 3<sup>rd</sup>. Henry Brough took the win in the GX200's, with Dave Keech coming home first in the GX160's.

In Class A1, which is for Junior 2 strokes, Luke McCaffrey took a commanding win to consolidate his lead in the championship. Lewis Baldock and Joe Lock had a great tussle for 2<sup>nd</sup> with Lewis taking the 2<sup>nd</sup> podium spot at the end with Joe finishing 3<sup>rd</sup>.

In the new Class E for direct drive 100cc's, which included a rolling start for this class, Sean Flynn took the lead on the first lap and held onto it till the chequered flag. Christian Bartley finished a comfortable 2<sup>nd</sup> with Thomas Dandridge finishing 3<sup>rd</sup>.
